

Dear Procrastinating Pedalers Club Members:

Our club is now accepting nominations for our 2018 Executive Board. Each Board position carries a two-year tenure, and meetings are held on the first Monday of each month. Elected Board members are expected to attend these meetings, and may only miss up to three meetings before being considered for removal.

If you are interested in nominating yourself for a position on the Board, or if you wish to nominate a fellow club member, send in your nominations to ppedalersmembers@gmail.com. If you are nominating someone, please make sure you have their permission prior to nomination. All nominees must be current club members.

The deadline for nominations is November 17th, 2017 at midnight. Elections will be held online from November 26th, 2017 through December 2nd, 2017 at midnight. You can meet your candidates on November 21st, 2017 at the general club meeting.

The following is a list of Board positions and brief descriptions of the duties involved with each position:

President: The President is the chief official representative at all functions, presides at meetings of the Executive Board and general membership, appoints committee directors, oversees committee activities, expedites club business, provides leadership in accomplishing the objectives of the club, and performs other duties as set forth in the By-laws.

Vice President: The Vice President assists the President in liaison and other duties, and will perform duties of the President in the absence or incapacity of the President.

Recording Secretary: The Recording Secretary records and preserves the minutes of the Executive Board meetings, and will perform additional duties as may be assigned by the President or Executive Board.

Membership Director: The Membership Director serves as primary contact and responds to membership requests, sends out renewal and new memberships by the end of each month, and coordinates with the Treasurer to communicate the monthly deposit and membership information that is part of the monthly finance report to the President.

Ride Director: The Ride Director coordinates with and encourages members to create and lead diverse rides, and may be responsible for planning and supervising organized bicycle rides and duties as may be set forth by the Executive Board.

Program Director: The Program Director is responsible for arranging programs at the monthly meetings.

Members at Large: 5 voting Board members who will perform duties as defined by the Executive Board and act in an advisory capacity.

Alternate Board Members: Alternate Board members are appointed by the Executive Board and can participate in discussions, but may not vote.
